

ORDINANCE NO. 599

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOSITION OF A SERVICE FEE FOR THE USE OF CREDIT CARDS FOR PAYMENT OF FINES AND FEES ADJUDGED BY THE YORKTOWN COURT.

Be it ordained by the Yorktown Town Council, Delaware County, State of Indiana, that pursuant to IC 33-37-6 a fee be imposed for the use of credit cards:

Section 1. The Yorktown Town Court is authorized to collect a Five Dollar (\$5.00) fee for the use of credit cards for the payment of fines and fees totaling less than \$200. Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for fines and fees \$200 up to \$375 and 3% of total fines and fees to be assessed as a service fee for monies owed over \$375.

Section 2. Monies collected, minus the credit card processing fees, shall be receipted into the General Fund of the Town of Yorktown.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Yorktown Town Council, Delaware County, State of Indiana.
